Welcome back to the last half-term of this academic year. For those of you who managed to get one, or some part, I hope you had a good half-term break and that the weather did not deter too many of your plans! I managed to a few days at the start of the holiday down in south Devon, where there was glorious sunshine – but promptly arrived back to rain, wind and the cold in Aylesbury!

I spoke with the children on Monday in assembly about our value of respect which we are thinking about this half-term. I showed them two music clips, and talked to them about how as audiences we show respect in different ways. If you can, ask your child what was unique about the artists who performed in the music clips, and just why we need to have respect for everyone, no matter what. The children showed such great responses during our assembly and understand how important the value is to everybody's lives. We have some very young children in our nursery, who do not stand a chance with an older child on a scooter whizzing past them with a large bag on! Thank you for your support with this

## Online Safety Tip of the Week

### <u>Managing Online Information – KS1</u>

Remind your child of safe search engines to use that are designed for children's internet searches. We typically use Kiddle. Speak to them about using key words in their searches and keeping it simple to help find the most suitable information.

### Managing Online Information – KS2

Remind your child about 'fake news'. Always use multiple sources to get your information, never assume something based on a headline, and use sites such as Internet Matters to help you identify fake news.

- Discuss the risks on physical and mental health
- Use age-appropriate language
- Discuss legal and illegal drugs
