Encouraging one another to only consume what we need, to fix what is broken, to reuse what we can, and be mindful of where our waste ends up.



Firstly, tap water is purified at our base in **Berryfields** and transported in large water tanks in our vans. We then pump this water up telescopic poles with brush heads at the end. The dirt is scrubbed from your Frames, Glass and Sills, then the window is rinsed and left to dry naturally - because the water is so pure it dries without leaving any marks.
