Whether you are part of our amazing team of volunteers or helping to reduce food waste by taking food home, we truly appreciate your contribution.

We recognise that our KFC distribution on Monday afternoons is extremely popular, and demand currently exceeds supply. To ensure fairness and allow as many families as possible to enjoy this treat, we are introducing a new system starting Monday, 3rd February.

New System Details:

- Limit: 1 bag of KFC per household/family, per calendar month.
- Sign-in: Everyone collecting KFC will need to sign in with their name and their children's class(es).
- Monthly Sheet: A new sign-in sheet will be used at the start of each calendar month.

This system will help us ensure that more families have the opportunity to access the KFC food. Volunteers who are actively collecting or distributing the chicken each week may take one bag per collection.

Children have the right to share freely with others what they learn, think and feel, by talking, drawing, writing or in any other way unless it harms other people.




